Note: The Exchequer turned over to the French 4,000,000 reales (500,000 pesos), evidently keeping the rest of the total, and the treasury secured one-fourth of the total at no interest. It is quite possible that not all the creditors on this list were Spanish citizens (See nos. 17, 19, 23, and 24). Only one contributor was female (See no. 22).
